### FLORIDA TRUCK MEET 2025 VENDOR AGREEMENT

This Vendor Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into on, 2025, by and between Truck Fever LLC ("Organizer"), a Florida limited liability company with its principal office located at 101 Marketside Avenue, Suite 404 PMB 245, Ponte Vedra, FL 32081, and ** ("Vendor"), a business entity with its principal office
located at ****.
RECITALS
WHEREAS, Organizer is hosting the <b>2025 Florida Truck Meet</b> ("Event"), to be held at <b>Orlando Speed World</b> , located at 19164 E Colonial Dr, Orlando, FL 32820, on <b>April 11, 2025, and April 12, 2025</b> , with vendor setup on <b>April 10, 2025</b> , and teardown on <b>April 13, 2025</b> ;
WHEREAS, Vendor wishes to participate as a vendor at the Event to promote and sell its products and services under the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement;
NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements contained herein, the parties agree as follows:
1. VENDOR SPACE & FEES 1.1 Vendor Space. Vendor shall be allocated a space at the Event based on the size and location requested and approved by the Organizer. The Vendor space shall be used solely for the purpose of promoting and selling Vendor's products and services.
1.2 <b>Payment Terms</b> . Vendor shall pay a non-refundable fee of \$ for the allocated space ("Fee"). Payment is due upon signing this Agreement. Vendor space will not be reserved or confirmed until the Fee is received in full by Organizer. All payments are final and non-refundable.
1.3 <b>Space Assignment</b> . Organizer will assign space locations at its discretion, taking into consideration the nature of the Vendor's business, the overall Event layout, and other relevant factors.
2 EVENT SCHEDIJI E & OPERATIONS

- 2.1 Event Dates and Hours. The Event shall be open to the public from 11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on April 11 and April 12, 2025. Vendor setup is scheduled for April 10, 2025, from 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., and Vendor teardown must be completed by 3:00 p.m. on April 13, 2025.
- 2.2 Vendor Booth Hours. Vendors must be present at their booths from 11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. each day for public access. After 4:00 p.m., the main event area will not be accessible to the public. The after-hours events, which run from 4:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m., will take place in designated areas, such as the Burnout Pit and Truck Tugs, and the Vendor booths will not be open to attendees during this time.

- 2.3 **Booth Appearance and Maintenance**. Vendor shall keep its space in a clean, orderly, and professional manner. Vendor is responsible for all trash removal and ensuring that the space remains free of debris.
- 2.4 **Display Restrictions**. All displays must be free-standing and must not obstruct the view of neighboring vendor spaces. No materials may extend beyond the designated vendor space or block fire exits.
- 2.5 **Staffing Requirements**. Vendor must provide adequate staff to manage its space during Event hours. The Organizer shall not be responsible for staffing or managing Vendor's space.

## 3. INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

- 3.1 **Certificate of Insurance (COI)**. Vendor shall maintain liability insurance covering property damage and bodily injury with limits of at least \$1,000,000 per occurrence. A valid COI listing "Truck Fever LLC" and "Orlando Speed World" as additional insured must be provided to the Organizer **no later than 14 days prior to the Event (March 28, 2025)**. Failure to provide the COI by the deadline may result in forfeiture of the Vendor's space, with no refund of fees paid.
- 3.2 **Liability Disclaimer**. Organizer is not responsible for any loss, damage, or injury suffered by Vendor, Vendor's employees, or any third party arising out of Vendor's participation in the Event.

### 4. WRISTBANDS, VEHICLE REGISTRATION & ADDITIONAL TERMS

- 4.1 Wristbands Allocation. Vendor will receive five (5) wristbands for every 40 feet of booth frontage. These wristbands are provided for Vendor staff only. Additional wristbands may be purchased online or at the gate. All Vendor personnel must have a wristband to access the Event grounds.
- 4.2 **Vehicle Registration**. All vehicles displayed in the Vendor's booth must be registered as "Show Trucks." Show Truck registration can be purchased online or at the gate for \$40 per vehicle. Each registered vehicle will receive a windshield decal and judging card. Vendor vehicles without proper registration will not be permitted in the show area.
- 4.3 **Trailer Parking**. If the Vendor requires trailer parking, it must be purchased separately for \$40. Trailer parking allows access from Thursday to Sunday with 24-hour access, and trailers may remain attached to tow vehicles without additional charge.
- 4.4 **Camping**. Onsite camping is available for \$250 per site, with spaces measuring 65 feet deep by 20 feet wide. Camping is primitive, with no water or power hookups available. Campers will have 24-hour access to the venue for the duration of the Event.

### 5. CANCELLATION & TERMINATION

5.1 **No Refunds**. All payments made to Organizer under this Agreement are non-refundable. Vendor acknowledges that cancellations made for any reason will not be refunded. However, credit for future events may be issued if cancellation is requested in writing more than 60 days prior to the Event.

5.2 **Termination by Organizer**. Organizer reserves the right to terminate this Agreement and Vendor's participation in the Event if Vendor breaches any term of this Agreement, including failure to provide required insurance or comply with Event rules.

### 6. INDEMNIFICATION

6.1 **Indemnification by Vendor**. Vendor agrees to indemnify, defend, and hold harmless Organizer, its affiliates, officers, directors, employees, agents, and Orlando Speed World from and against any and all claims, liabilities, losses, damages, expenses, or judgments arising from Vendor's participation in the Event, including, but not limited to, any breach of this Agreement or negligence by Vendor or its representatives.

# 7. ADDITIONAL TERMS

- 7.1 **Compliance with Laws**. Vendor agrees to comply with all applicable local, state, and federal laws, including health and safety regulations.
- 7.2 **Force Majeure**. Organizer shall not be liable for any failure to perform its obligations under this Agreement due to events beyond its reasonable control, including acts of God, war, fire, strikes, pandemics, or other events of a similar nature.
- 7.3 **Governing Law & Jurisdiction**. This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Florida, and any disputes arising from this Agreement shall be resolved in the courts of St. Johns County, Florida.
- 7.4 **Entire Agreement**. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and supersedes all prior agreements or understandings, whether written or oral. Any modifications must be made in writing and signed by both parties.
